

3-D printers are one of the latest trends in modern technology. One day Hull talked to his boss about the idea of a 3-D printer, but as it wasn't useful for their business he wasn't interested. Despite this disappointment Charles never stopped working on his invention. He worked at the company during the day, and at night he focused on designing his 3-D printer!

The first model of Hull's 3-D printer was very large and heavy. It also cost hundreds of thousands of dollars! Because he was unable to travel with his invention, Charles made videos showing how it worked. At the time the car industry in America was at a disadvantage internationally and were impressed. They were quick to see the benefits of Charles' invention as it allowed them to make prototypes instantly, saving valuable time and money.

Production and development of 3-D printers grew, and the rest, as they say, is History!
