## **THE FOOD THAT SHOWED YOUR WEALTH**

It wasn't only the land masses of the Americas that Christopher Columbus discovered on behalf of 15<sup>th</sup> century Europeans. **1.** ..... Queen Isabella of Spain thought they were delicious, and she wasn't the only European to think so. **2.** ..... The unusually large and sweet pineapple fascinated European gardeners. However, nearly 200 years passed before they succeeded in growing pineapples. **3.** ..... In America, meanwhile, the pineapple became a symbol of a woman's social position. Only the richest families could buy pineapples from the fast ships that delivered them still fresh. When women held dinner parties, therefore, they placed pineapples in the middle of the table. **4.** ..... Some people even rented pineapples for an evening just to impress their friends!

**AN ENJOYABLE VISIT**

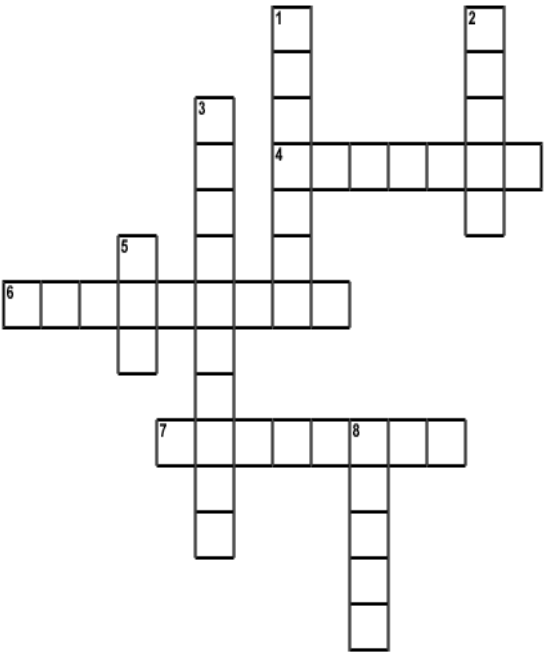

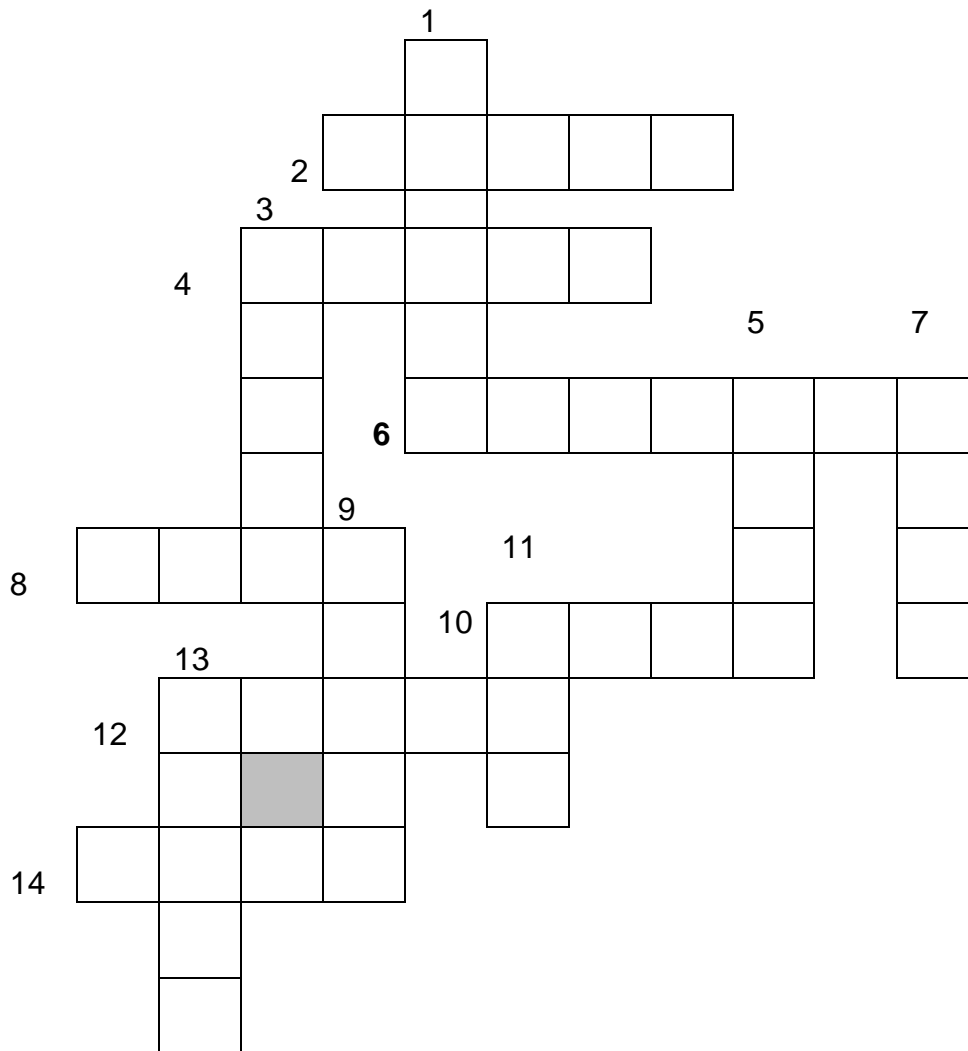
