Tuna: friend or foe?

In countries across the world, thousands of people rely upon fish such as tuna as a healthy alternative to red meat. In North America alone tuna is eaten in over 90 per cent of homes.

Tuna appeals to so many people because it has lots of benefits. It's a great source of protein as well as it is low in saturated fat. It is also a source of omega 3 fatty acids. Furthermore, tuna is easy to find and cheap to buy.

However, tuna also has a serious impact on our health. Scientists have realised that poisoning is a major issue as fish like tuna contain mercury, which is harmful to humans. Most tuna is also packed in cans where it is exposed to the chemical bisphenol A (BPA). Scientists believe BPA can impact brain development and even behaviour. Another less serious issue is that fresh tuna is also high in salt, having 42 milligrams per 85 gram serving. After companies finish adding extra salt when packing it, this increases to a shocking 320 milligrams! Due to these disadvantages, many governments are now advising people not to eat lots of tuna. Despite being an important part of diets around the world, tuna is now facing an uncertain future.
